Full-time graduate enrollment is normally 9-12 credits per semester. The length of the program varies depending on degree requirements and course load per semester. A typical three credit-hour course normally requires three hours of classroom instruction plus additional reading and research per week over a semester period.

Applicants must follow the admission procedures specified in the University catalog, College of Graduate Studies Web site or listed at the degree program Web site.

Once you have submitted your application and \$50 application fee, you will need to submit the following:

Official transcripts from each college/university attended

Official admission test scores such as GRE or MAT as required by your graduate program\*

Supplementary application documents as required by your graduate program\*\*

*International applicants must also provide official evaluation of transcripts through a professional evaluation agency and TOEFL scores \*\*\**

\* GACE scores are required for some programs.

\*\* Many programs require the applicant to present a statement of purpose, career goals and objectives as part of the application package. The admissions application specifies these requirements. See the program Web site for details.

\*\*\* The TOEFL will be waived for students who have graduated from a U.S. college or university.
